If reserving a hotel by yourself is preferred, you must take care of the transportation problem without help of the organizers when your hotel is not in the selected list.

Visa

To enter Vietnam foreigners need an entry visa which is usually granted at Vietnamese embassies and consulates abroad. Any visas can be applied for directly there. Business travellers should apply for a visa through the Vietnamese host. In our case, the local organizers of the symposium should apply for a visa approval for their foreign guests at the Ministry of Public Security of Vietnam. After that, the relevant Vietnamese embassy or consulate is informed of the approval by fax. You will be notified about the date of this fax as well as an approval number. You must then send (or bring in person) (1) your passport, (2) approval number and date of fax, (3) two passport photos, to your Vietnamese embassy or consulate to obtain your visa. In general, some visa fees are charged.

If you want the organizers to apply for your visa approval, please submit your registration before April 15, 2002 together with your personal data:

(1) Full name, (2) Date and place of birth, (3) Profession, (4) Passport number, (5) Date and place of issue and expiration date, (6) Nationality (original and present), (7) Date and point of entry to Vietnam, (8) Length of stay in Vietnam, (9) Which Vietnamese embassy or consulate do you want to obtain your visa from? Please provide the same information about your accompanying persons.

Transportation

From Noibai Airport to hotels

There are minibuses and taxis from Noibai Airport to Hanoi. It is strongly recommended to choose an Airport Taxi. It costs about 10 USD from the airport to anywhere within Hanoi. To avoid unacceptably high prices, please keep in mind to ask the taxi-driver before the trip to Hanoi.

Within Hanoi

There are 13 bus lines in Hanoi. The bus service is cheap, although infrequent. A nice way to navigate the city is to rent a pedicab or motorbike with driver. Negotiate a fare beforehand. Taxi is inexpensive, safe and comfortable. Flag fall is fixed at an amount (depending on taxi companies), which takes you 2 km, and then every kilometer thereafter costs another amount (about 7000 VND/km).

From hotel to conference place

If you live in certain hotels selected by the organizers in advance, the organizers will try to arrange a bus to take you to the conference place everyday. But this is only done in the early morning (the beginning of each working day) and late afternoon (the end of each working day). Otherwise, taxi and motorbike are a reasonable means of transport. In this situation, traffic jam in Hanoi at rush hours should be taken into account.

Weather

The climate in Hanoi is generally agreeable except for hot and humid months (May-July). August is at the end of summer with occasional typhoons. The temperature is between 18°C and 35°C.

Currency

The currency issued by the Vietnam State Bank is the dong (abbreviated "_" or VND). Bank notes in denominations of 100_, 200_, 500_, 1,000_, 2,000_ 5,000_, 10,000_, 20,000_, 50,000_ and 100,000_ are presently in circulation. Traveler's checks can be exchanged for Vietnamese dong only at authorized exchange banks. Credit cards (American Express, Visa, Master card) can be used in banks, travel agencies, hotels, and major restaurants. US and some other currencies are exchanged for Vietnamese dong and treasury notes in banks, exchange bureaus, hotels, and jewelry shops. The exchange rate changes constantly.
